

POSTING YOUR 911 ADDRESSING SIGN

Emergency responders can only help you when they find your location. Every second counts during an emergency and posting your physical address number allows emergency responders to save critical time especially in reaching rural parts of Burleson County. Homes are often hidden from view at the beginning of a driveway, so only posting your numbers on your home may not help responders recognize where you live since they must first find your driveway to find your home.

Your 911 reflective sign should be installed near your driveway entrance (as you enter your property), and be clearly visible from the main road from either direction. We recommend that you purchase a double-sided sign (numbers appear on both sides of the sign) so that emergency responders can view the sign from different directions. Install the sign 3ft from the ground and not more than 5ft, from ground level to the bottom of the sign. The sign must be kept clear of vegetation.

In addition, if there is more than one home sharing a driveway, post the physical address for each home at the driveway entrance and on each home along the driveway to ensure emergency responders find the correct home.
